\$1.00 a week will . . .
(\$52 a year)

- ❑ Provide a week of meals to two elderly homebound Callawegians
- ❑ Send two Cub Scouts to a summer day camp program
- ❑ Feed 10 kids a nutritious breakfast at Head Start
- ❑ House a family of four at HAVEN House for five days
- ❑ Provide a counseling session to a troubled adolescent
- ❑ Provide Swimming and Water Safety instruction for two children
- ❑ Provide 1 nights lodging for a family that has lost everything in a fire
- ❑ Provide CPR and First Aid Training so someone can save a life
- ❑ Pay for a week of summer camp for a child at the YMCA
- ❑ Pay for two sessions of gymnastics, soccer, t-ball or basketball for a child at the YMCA
- ❑ Purchase 20 pounds of food for the hungry
- ❑ Provide 2 nights emergency shelter for a homeless family
- ❑ Provide 4-H membership dues for four youth for one year
- ❑ Pay for an attorney to give legal advice to a domestic violence victim
- ❑ Provide 6 Girl Scouts with handbooks

\$2.00 a week will . . .
(\$104 a year)

- ❑ Provide seven senior citizens with a nutritionally balanced meal at the Senior Center for a week
- ❑ Assist someone without Medicaid or insurance transportation to life saving chemotherapy treatments in Columbia
- ❑ Transport 20 pallets of food from the food bank to the food pantry
- ❑ Fund Adult Basic Education instruction to ten individuals for ten days
- ❑ Send one youth to 4-H camp
- ❑ Pay for an attorney to provide court representation to obtain an order of protection for a domestic violence victim
- ❑ Provide training so someone can become a CPR and First Aid Instructor.

\$5.00 a week will . . .
(\$260 a year)

- Provide the resources needed to start two new Boy Scout troops
- Transport a person to and from physical therapy 3 times a week
- Provide bedding, toiletries and snack for 10 individuals at Wiley House for one night
- Pay for aftercare treatment for a woman attempting to regain custody of her child
- Fund two weeks of shelter for a homeless family
- Fund two families with emergency utility assistance
- Pay for an attorney to represent an abuse victim to obtain a simple divorce and permanently separate the victim from the abuser

\$10.00 a week will . . .
(\$520 a year)

- Provide daycare for a month and the Head Start Center
- Stage a Pinewood Derby race for more than 100 Cub Scouts
- Provide grief materials for 120 families for 13 months
- Pay for therapy for an individual having a difficult time adjusting to the loss of a parent or spouse
- Purchase CPR Manikins so the Red Cross can train people to save lives.
- Fund five individuals with life sustaining medication for a month
- Fund utility and rent deposits for a family establishing a home in Callaway County.
- Transport food for 1,570 backpacks for Buddy Pack to elementary schools for the school year
- Supply 4-H project literature for 1 project for every member in Callaway County 4-H
- Pay for an attorney to represent an adult abuse victim to obtain a divorce, establish child custody and child support
- Feed 4 Kingdom Project employees a well balanced, nutritious noon meal
