\$1.00 a week will . . .
(\$52 a year)

- buy 20 pounds of food or two nights of emergency shelter.
- help to cover the cost of two important medical maintenance appointments on a wheelchair lift bus.
- provide immediate advice to a domestic violence victim to ensure that the victim has a safety plan that will prevent further immediate abuse.
- pay for a child to play 5/-6th grade tackle football.
- provide 3-4 pieces of fresh fruit to a homebound client weekly.
- provide CPR or First Aid Training for a class of 10 High School students.
- provide 260 miles of travel to doctor visits for elderly clients.
- help send two Cub Scouts to Cub Scout Day Camp.
- provide one year of 4-H membership to five youth.
- pay for a single counseling session for a person looking for direction after a major disruption to their life.

\$2.00 a week will . . .
(\$104 a year)

- provide two nights lodging for a family that has lost everything in a fire.
- helps to provide life saving rides to an indigent person needing dialysis treatments in Columbia.
- assist a domestic violence victim in obtaining an order of protection to secure the victim's safety.
- pay for travel expenses to bring 20 pallets of food back to Callaway County from the Food Bank.
- sponsor two counselors to Counselor Camp & two 4-H memberships.
- provide one year of 4-H membership to ten youth.
- provide 7 hours of respite for seniors unsafe to stay alone.
- pay for an individual to attend an 8-week group related to parenting or drug and alcohol issues.
- provide a ½ campership for a Boy Scout to attend Hohn Scout Reservation.
- fund Adult Basic Education Instruction to ten individuals for ten days.

\$5.00 a week will . . .
(\$260 a year)

- help to provide essential trips to local persons that need to attend doctor's appointments, trips to the pharmacy or physical therapy.
- pay for two meals to a homebound client weekly.
- provide clothing & shoes for two people affected by a disaster.
- sponsor two youth to 4-H Camp
- provide almost 16 hours of home chores and meal preparations for seniors unable to do these tasks.
- allow a feuding family (parents and teens) to attend five counseling sessions to discuss issues regarding how they treat each other and how to deal more effectively with their problems.
- fund two weeks of shelter for a family facing homelessness.
- assist two families with emergency financial assistance to prevent homelessness.
- assist a domestic violence victim in obtaining orders of protection to protect both the abused parent and abused children
- provide representation for a victim of domestic violence in obtaining a divorce that will permanent separate the victim from the abuser

\$10.00 a week will . . .
(\$520 a year)

- provide utility and rent deposit for a family establishing a home in Callaway County
- help cover the costs to shuttle low income families with children to/from dental appointments that Medicaid will not cover.
- provide registration assistance to 35 at risk youth to join Scouting who otherwise might not be able to due to financial hardships.
- allow a person with serious issues related to their addiction, violent behaviors and depression to undergo a typical course of therapy over a two month period.
- pay for four meals to a homebound client weekly.
- provide Babysitters training for eight youth so they know how to safely provide care for infants and young children.
- purchase a food box to supplement 14 meals for a family of four
- provide almost nine nursing visits to seniors or disabled individuals in need.
